- © Take a group photograph (being mindful and sympathetic to participants having photograph permissions). Add your photograph to the County Leaders Facebook page.
- Make something to remember taking part in the BIG BIG Sleepover. Some ideas could include:
 - Paint a stone, putting the date and venue of your event
 - Make a Teddy Bear Fridge Magnet
 - Paint a mug or a plate
- © Decorate a paper plate in your chosen theme.
- © Hold a "Nightwear" Fashion Show.

© Make a hot chocolate, why not add cream, marshmallows or anything else you fancy to make it a luxury one! © Make a Campfire Biscuit. Use Matchmakers, marshmallows, jellies etc © Hold a Soft Toy Animal Pet Show. © Decorate a piece of toast, with a smiley face. © Make some delicious "smores" or toast marshmallows. © Enjoy an active activity. e.g: **Bowling** Canoeing Kayaking Swimming Walking Visit a local attraction.

© Play beetle drive or come up with your own version to suit your theme.

© Wait til it's dark - then make a picture on the floor with glow sticks.

© Make a trefoil brooch - using beads. Follow the instructions below:

You need:

42 small pony beads 1 pipe cleaner Small safety pin

Bend the pipe cleaner in half and thread the small safety pin so that it is in the middle.

Thread 7 beads on one side of the safety pin and 7 on the other, twist the pipe cleaner so that the beads form a circle.

Thread 14 beads on each of the pipe cleaner ends, twist the pipe cleaner to make 2 more loops with the beads. Twist the remaining bits of pipe cleaner together to make the stem of the Trefoil.



- Try the Mouth Wash Challenge. Everyone together brushes their teeth, using their toothbrush, toothpaste and a cup of water!
- © Enjoy a good book.
- © How about making up a group dance? Could be to the tune of a well known song e.g. hokey cokey.
- © Produce your own "Sleepover" Song or Rap.
- Make a wind chime or a dream catcher
- © Take it a step further and make your own instruments to create your own band.
- Make a new friend.
- © Have a competition to blow the biggest, longest or most interesting bubble you can (not with chewing gum).
- © Scavenger Hunt. Some ideas;
 - How many items can you get in a matchbox?
 - © Find something related to each letter of your theme name
 - © Colours of the Rainbow

☺	Make a Gadget (small or large!)
©	Learn a new campfire song. Sing it on your own or as a group.
©	Make a mini raft and float it in a bowl of water. Try lighting a night light on it.
©	Follow a trail. This could be a day or night time one.
©	Try stick weaving. Lots of instructions online.
©	Hold an early morning keep fit session. For example, try Tai Chi, Yoga or some simple stretching exercises.
☺	Have a puppet show. This could either be making your own or how about trying shadow puppets.
©	Watch a film - ready for bed in your pyjamas etc. Make sure you are nice and cosy.
©	Lie in your sleeping bag and with your torches perform a light show on the ceiling. You could put a piece of coloured cellophane over the end of your torch, so you have different colours.
©	Go one better and do it to music.
☺	Sleep out under the stars.
©	Play woodland noughts and crosses with sticks and stones.
☺	Make pancakes and try different fillings. Guides and Rangers could try this on a Trangia.
☺	Decorate a cake or biscuit to celebrate taking part in the BIG BIG Sleepover.

- © Do an "I Spy" Challenge on your journey to your BIG BIG Sleepover venue.
- Have a go at bark rubbing.
- © Go one further and make it into a card to give to your new friend.
- Make contact with another Unit taking part in the County BIG BIG Sleepover through Skype, Facetime etc. Help can be given to link Units up with each other.
- © After the event email 5 photographs into the County Office showing the fun you have had. We look forward to seeing some big smiles and some action shots!
- © Listen to some relaxing and soothing music to help you go to sleep.
- © Another activity for when it is dark try Glow Stick Bowling fill pop bottles with water and add a glow stick!
- Have a water relay race.
- © Decorate your venue, make a gateway for your camp or decorate a pillowcase.
